
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WONDERFEST 2024

AMIRA, an AI-enabled reading practice for students, focuses on improving pronunciation, through an error detection technology. This allows the software to listen to a child's utterance and determine whether the word is pronounced correctly. The program is highly beneficial for students, as it adjusts the level of stories based on their progress and automatically records real-time observations. It also provides age and level appropriate stories to enhance further reading practice.
