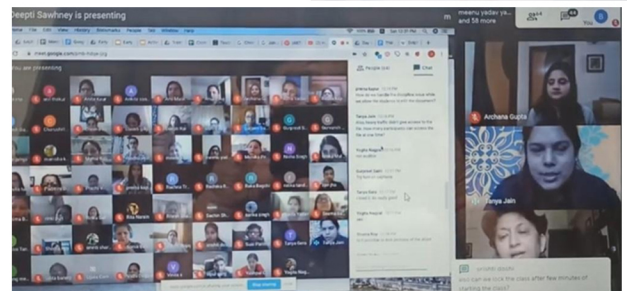
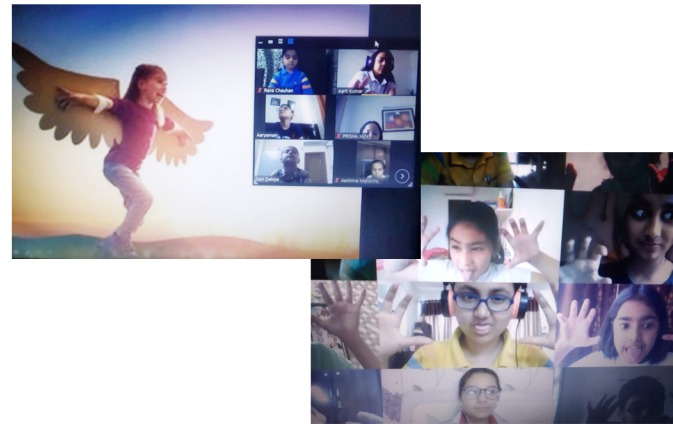
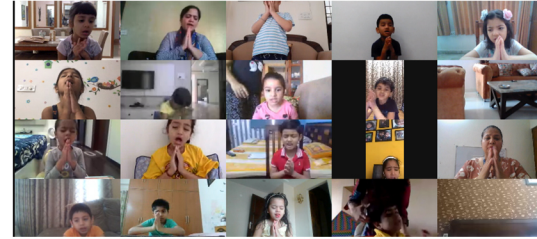
### JUMPSTART TO NEW ACADEMIC SESSION

For all new admission for session 2020-2021, the school held a 'Virtual Parent Orientation'. Having shared all the written material like features, guidelines, Zoom classes were launched, with a virtual tour of each wing, followed by introductions by each teacher. A Welcome assembly by the teachers made all the students feel cherished and together they formulated class rules. In all, it was 'real-time session beginning'. By the first week of April, classes for grade XI too had started..

## PHASE 1

### EXPLORING THE RESOURCES

Looking at the limitations that zoom was posing, our leadership team started working behind the scenes to explore various teaching-learning portals available that would offer maximum, best, and easy-to-use resources to the students and teachers. And so, the school switched to Google Suite, as a best available platform.

## PHASE 2

### EXTENSIVE TEACHER TRAINING

The teachers were given rigorous training and hands-on online practice of each and every app/module/tool/application for 6 continuous days by a seasoned Google professional. Wanting to leave no stone unturned or rather no online tool unexplored, teachers connected with one another in small groups to become digital-savvy teachers and acquire mastery over G-Suite. These in-house trainings ensured optimal use of the plethora of digital tools that are available in G-Suite.

## PHASE 3

### LAUNCHING G SUITE

There was a step-wise introduction to the new module and parents were informed of the same, followed by creating a unique G Suite id for each student, then giving parents a virtual tour of the Google classroom, creating an ethical code of conduct for the students and the parents regarding the use of the G Suite platform and sharing the same with all stakeholders.

## PHASE 4

### SETTING UP THE CLASSROOM

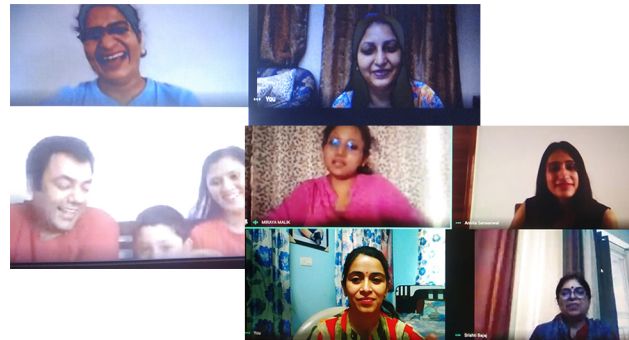
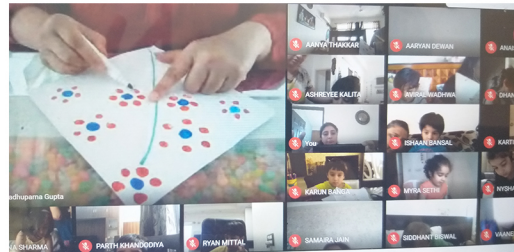
All teachers including the academic, sports and activity teachers started with setting up their classrooms. Now, each class has created its own digital library including self created Ebooks and other resource material.

Timely submission of students' work is ensured, followed by prompt feedback by the teachers.

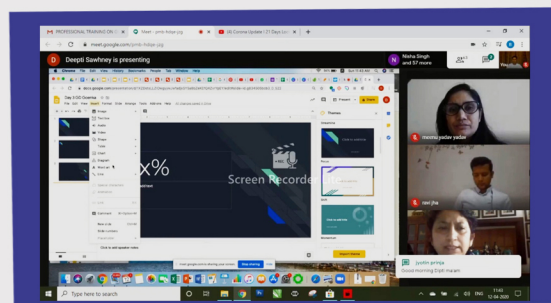
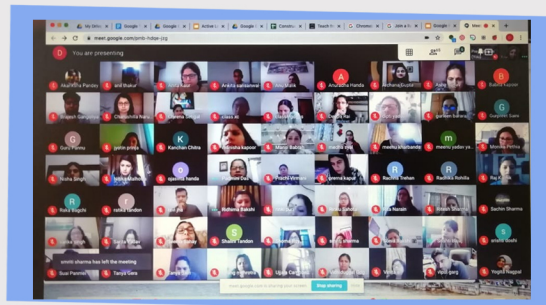
## SIX DAY G-SUITE TRAINING

Looking ahead and preparing for it today is the culture of GDGPS Sector 48. With an understanding that a comprehensive platform is required to fulfil the highly complex and dynamic teaching learning process, the school procured the Google Suite domain soon after the lock-down.

G Suite being a highly evolved module, it was important that the teaching faculty develops an in-depth understanding of the entire module, both from the perspective of the teacher and the student. Employing the services of a seasoned Google professional having expertise of the domain, the school organised special training for its teachers before switching to G Suite.

Teachers went through a week long extensive training of the module. The training sessions were conducted in the evenings on working days, after the teachers completed their zoom classes, and all off days and weekends during the day, for the core team of teachers. This core team then went on to train the entire faculty in small groups. Together the team held practice and training sessions to gain mastery over the module. Teachers started using various applications available to create priceless resources for all to use.

The implementation of G Suite is being done with a long term vision in mind. The school shall continue to use the module and its exclusive features well into the session, after the school reopens.



## ‘An Educator's Guide to Delivering Virtual Lessons’

An informative webinar was conducted by Mr Satyendra Arora to equip educators all across the globe with a hands-on guide to effectively deliver virtual lessons in the times of lockdown .

He provided information about various E-Learning platforms and tools to create digital classrooms. The information provided about techniques of managing virtual classrooms and assessments for the students was very critical in asynchronous teaching learning environment.

## Artificial Intelligence and Data Analysis

Mr. Manvender Singh (Chief Data Science Mentor) INSAID conducted a workshop on Importance of DATA SCIENCE in today's world. He suggested that the theory and practical knowledge of AI are like the two sides of a coin and need to be managed in a judicious manner especially at school level.

He explained why Data Scientist is considered the best job profile and how the demand is going to shoot to 400%. He did talk about the safety concerns with AI as it has been with every invention, be it fire or electricity. There are dangers involved with the advent of AI but with the advancement in technology happening at an exponential pace in the recent times, we need to be well equipped to meet the challenges. Also he briefed about the various courses that INSAID is offering.

## E Training – Numpy Language

Mr. Naveen Gupta, PGT Computer Science, St. Mark's School and co-author of the NCERT Computer Science book, conducted an online four hours hands on workshop on CLASS XII Topic “Python Numpy”.

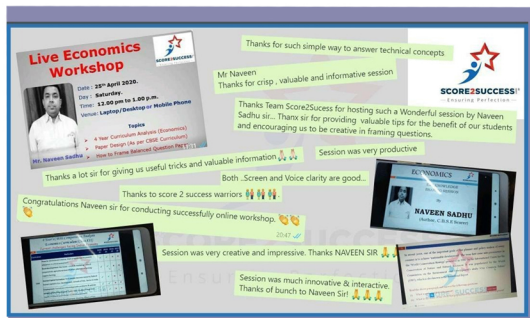
The workshop covered topics such as installation and use of various modules such as Matplotlib and Numpy. Operations on trigonometric functions and logarithmic functions were covered using math and numpy module. Also, trigonometric and logarithmic graphs using numpy was covered. In this hands-on course, the entire team of 103 teachers gained experience on Numpy programming and its features.



## Capacity Building Programme - Classroom Management

A workshop on capacity building programme on classroom management and developing a growth mindset was held that saw 130 participants attending the online workshop.

The resource person emphasized on how the mindset of a person plays an important role in personality development. Audio of an interview with Carol Dewek, the author of the book 'Growth Mindset' was played. Moderated by Salman Khan of the Khan Academy, the author in the interview highlighted the importance of growth mindset in today's times.



## Webinar on Economics

Lockdown actually means unlocking the doors to new horizons of collaborative learning through webinars. One such interesting Webinar on Economics was hosted by Score to Success. This was a platform for authors, Commerce professionals and renowned educators to join hands together to illuminate young minds. Mr. Naveen Sadhu, a seasoned PGT teacher with more than 22 years of teaching experience was the key speaker. Ms. Asha Yadav, PGT – Economics represented our school.

Intellectual deliberations and debate ensued on CBSE curriculum with the focus on the subject of Economics. The webinar delegates put forward practical suggestions for teaching the subject and designing the paper for the students.

## CBSE Workshop

A happy mind is a receptive mind. For children to learn and imbibe what is being taught at school, creating a happy learning environment in class is an absolute must. To enable our teachers hone this skill even further, a CBSE workshop on HOW TO CREATE HAPPY CLASSROOMS, was conducted by Ms. Charu Maini, Principal, DAV School.

She also shared the importance of a teacher having a stress free environment, to be able to impart education freely. 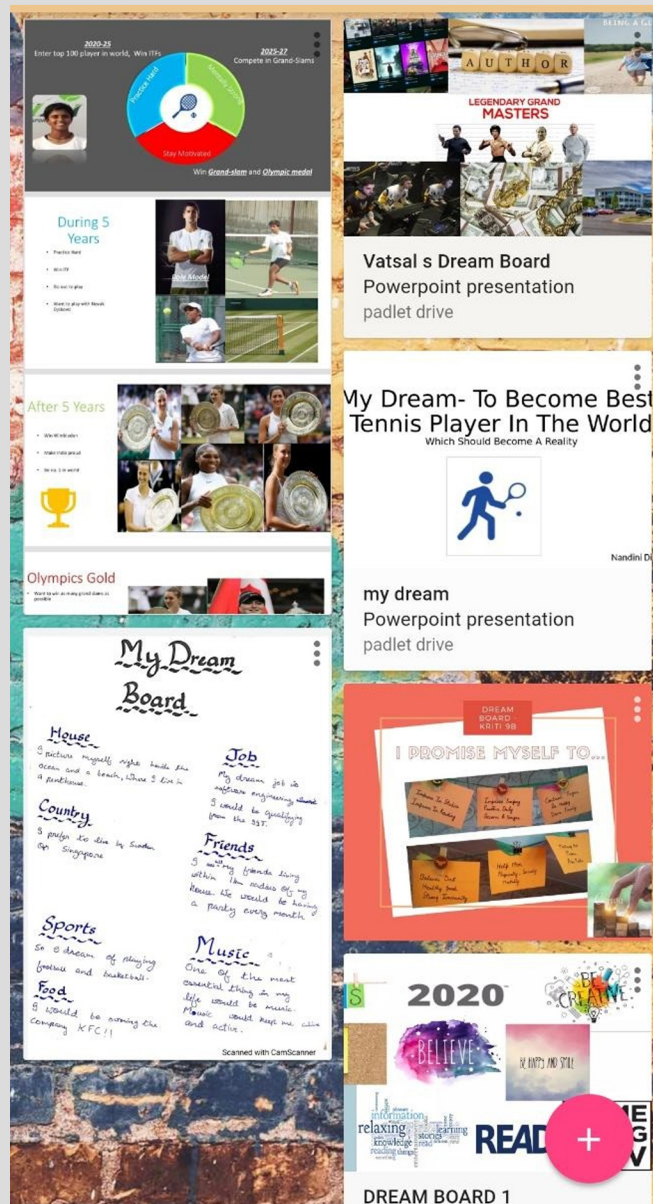
## I DISCOVER ME

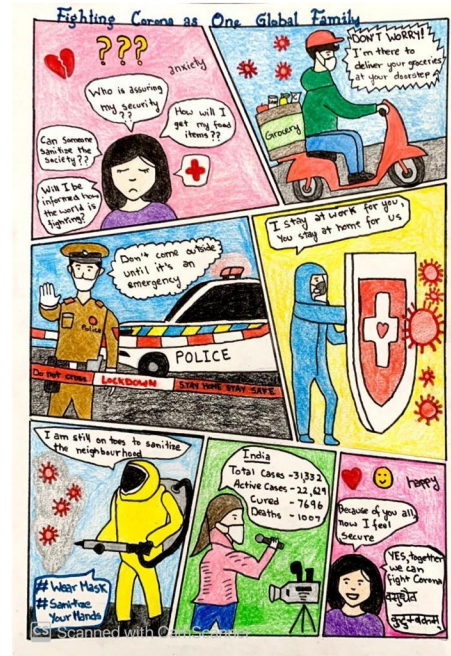
# ACCOLADES

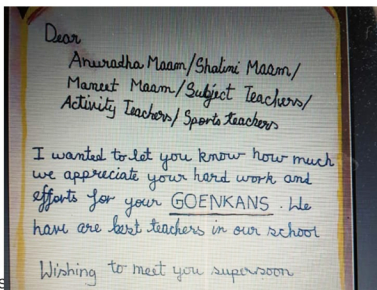
Would like to add that we are extremely thankful to you and to the entire staff of GDGPS, activity teachers, Arunima Ma'am for making these classroom sessions so interesting.
